## UUFW Board of Directors Meeting Minutes September 16, 2025

Marilyn Nash called the meeting to order at 2:08 p.m.

Present: Marilyn Nash, President, Margo Kephardt, Immediate Past President; Jean St. Clair, Vice-President; Paul Oakley, Minister; Peggy Anders, Treasurer; Madeleine Dupre, Secretary; Nancy Trimble, Clint Nicely, and Mike Drumheller, Members-at -large.

- Approval of Consent Agenda. Nothing was pulled from the consent agenda and it was approved unanimously.
- II. Old business. General review of identified board goals/actions.
  - a. Stewardship. The Stewardship Committee met on September 15, 2025. Nancy Trible, Committee Chair, referred to the meeting report, posted in the discussion agenda folder. She identified two priorities: increasing awareness of the work of the stewardship committee and increasing the level of participation in fundraising events.
    - i. Nancy reviewed the plans for OcktoberFest 2025.
    - She discussed additional fundraising initiatives: Blue Stone Sky concert (June 2026) and English Tea Party (Laura Hyatt).

## b. Communication.

- Zoom live-feed option for services. Mike Drumheller is waiting to hear from the Harrisonburg UU Fellowship about strategies for broadcasting services via Zoom live feed.
- c. Remembrance Garden. The task force will meet again on Saturday, September 27, 2025 to develop the Remembrance Garden policies and procedures.
- d. Termites/Pest management. Margot Kephardt reviewed termite control proposals submitted by local pest control companies. She made a motion to hire Eco Shield for termite treatment. Mike Drumheller 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed unanimously. Margot will request written contract from Eco Shield.
- e. Personnel handbook. No updates at this time.
- f. **Green Sanctuary**. No updates at this time.
- g. Stocking/filling of the food pantry. Rev. Paul asked Savannah to write a brief description/summary about Food Pantry procedures for the newsletter and eblast.

 Buildings and grounds. Ongoing discussion about building maintenance/ landscaping and lawncare. Marilyn Nash and Jean St. Clair will identify potential individuals/companies to provide weeding, mulching, pruning, and mowing services.

## III. New Business:

- a. Food service cart. Margot Kephardt and Peggy Anders discussed a request made by the Hospitality Committee for a food service cart. Rev. Paul identified possible strategies for funding this purchase.
- b. Security concerns. Marilyn Nash shared concerns expressed by a member of the fellowship relative to security and safety. Board members identified three possible strategies for addressing these concerns: (1) asking local police department to schedule officer drive by on Sunday mornings (2) Create a Wayside Pulpit (3) install security cameras on UUFW property. No action taken at this time.
- IV. Announcements. Rev. Paul announced that UUFW hired a nursey worker.
